Aims

The training course "Teaching on the Subject of HIV/AIDS by using the e-learning methodology" prepares educators and trainers to teach/train on the HIV/AIDS subject by using the e-learning methodology.

Objectives:

- to improve the general ICT skills and competences of using e-learning tools;
- to improve the pedagogical competences of planning the HIV/AIDS curriculum and adapting it to various target groups' needs;
- the methodological competences for organization and management of didactic activities in the virtual space.

By the end of the course, the participants:

- will be familiar with the concept of e-learning methodology;
- will discover new methods of education on HIV/AIDS subject;
- will develop new ICT skills by using the web based learning;
- will develop the methodological competences;
- will be able to put the e-learning methodology in practice in their context, both to other potential trainers and to their end-beneficiary groups.

CONTENT

1. E-learning methodology

1.1 *A new and innovative approach* for HIV/AIDS education based on the e-learning solution;

1.2 E-AIDS web platform, an *integrated solution* for HIV/AIDS education: web based information, online learning and training.

3.7 Monitoring the online course and evaluating the learners.

Methodology

The course consists of presentations of the e-learning platform made by representatives of the E-AIDS project, presentations of the HIV/AIDS learning methodology made by experts in the field, discussions focused on the new methods of education on HIV/AIDS subject and workshops on using the e-learning platform.

The workshops include: creating learning materials, designing the evaluation tools, set-up the online course – defining the aims and the objectives, choosing the content and the learning materials, simulation of an online course management.

The participants will work as mentors for their colleagues. They will publish and promote courses, manage the subscription and monitoring the courses, manage the learning process, evaluate the learners and monitor the learners' progress, communicate with learners by means of the online platform.

The participants will also be involved in learning activities. As learners, they will use the platform (the learners' desktop) for subscription to the courses and participation in the learning process.

Follow-up

The participants to the course are invited to use the E-Aids platform in order to create and manage online courses on HIV/AIDS education. They can use the course support and the CD containing the training modules to organize trainings and adapt it to the other learning and cultural contexts. They will add the new materials and contribute to the growth of the platform. They will disseminate the new learning methodology at local and national level and stimulate further development of the HIV/AIDS education.
