EUREKA, like Horizon 2020, is a platform for research focusing on <u>turning new technologies into marketable products</u>.

EUREKA was launched at the initiative of 17 European countries, including not only current members of the EU.

Both instruments Horizon 2020 and Eureka were created not in opposition but to complement each other, and continue today to work in synergy as many of EUREKA's support instruments complete Horizon 2020 or are even directly integrated in the flagship programme. Where EUREKA can help the most in the accomplishment of Horizon 2020's objectives is in the completion of what is called the European Research Area.

<u>Eurostars is a EU funding programme dedicated to SMEs</u> focusing on innovative technologies. It is an part of the offer for small businesses in Horizon 2020, in complement with the future SME instrument. The objective with Eurostars under Horizon 2020 is to <u>help small companies grow to middle-sized ones</u>, to become internationally-open businesses.
